## Dr. Thieu Ngoc Lan Phuong



### **research fellow**

As a Vietnamese university student, he received a joint 2008.5-year scholarship from the FAO and the Hungarian Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development in 5 to the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of Szent István University in Budapest. During his university studies, from 2010 he participated in the gene conservation work of farm animals in KÁTKI and then in HÁGK. In 2012, he won the special prize of CEVA-PROPHYLAXIA with his TDK thesis on the deep-frozen storage of spermatozoa of Hungarian fallow guinea fowls. In March 2014, he passed the state exam with excellent results at the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of Szent István University, where he took dr. vet. title. In July 2014, he became an employee of HÁGK as a scientific trainee in the fields of applied reproductive biology, animal health, animal welfare and conservation of indigenous pet gene reserves. Since June 2014, he has been an active member of the Hungarian Association for the Conservation of Pet Breeders, a breeding organization of indigenous poultry breeds. Since 2015, he has been continuing his work as a PhD student, the aim of which is to investigate the gene conservation and utilization methods of the indigenous poultry breeds of Hungary and Vietnam.
